## Management Profile

- Strong traffic/compaction tolerance, yield and superior forage quality
- Adapted to all U. S. production areas where fall dormancy 3, 4, or 5 varieties are recommended
- A4535 is expected to fit the traditional 3 or 4 harvest systems or rotational grazing programs
- This variety has a medium maturity to one-tenth flower and an average rate of recovery after harvest to fit well with cool season grasses or other legumes in mixtures
- No soil type or management limitations are anticipated

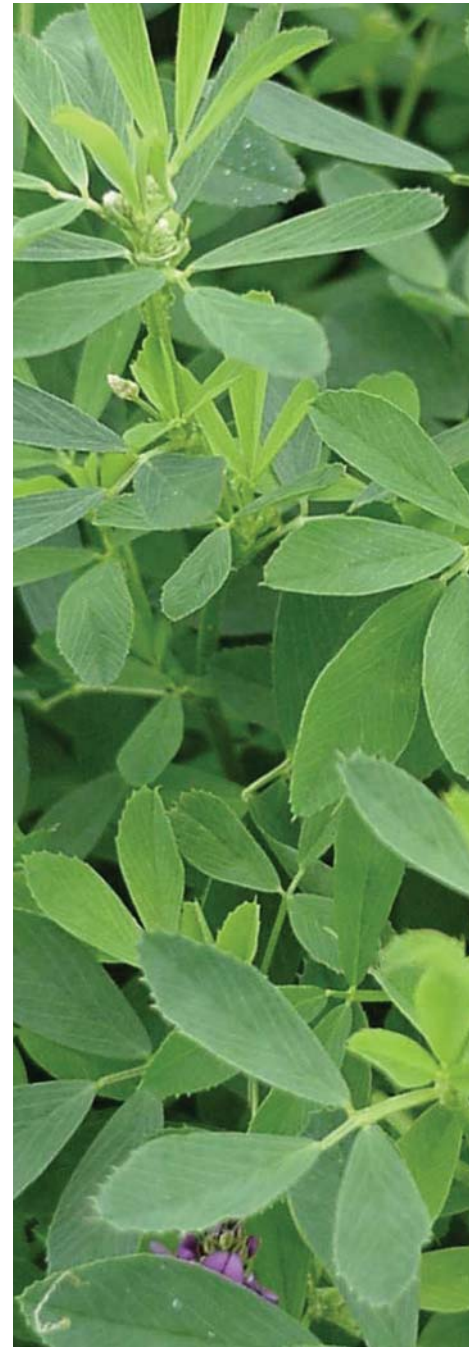
