Boulevard Mixture

Boulevard Mix is designed for use along boulevards and areas adjacent to parking lots. It is ideal for any area where salt has been used through the winter to melt ice or snow. This special mix is also suited for saline soils that are naturally salty and have a high pH level, detrimental to established grasses.

Alkaligrass is a slow-growing perennial bunchgrass with leaf texture similar to fine fescue. Secretariat perennial ryegrass contributes a quick start to the growth of the mix. This will be a long-lasting seed mixture.



Recommended Usage

Boulevard Mix is recommended for areas affected by either naturally salty soils or areas exposed to winter road salt. This mixture will tolerate salt & pH levels that are detrimental to the establishment of other grasses.

Suggested Maintenance

This mixture can be mowed between 1/2" - 3", or it can be left un-mowed. It will respond well to one application of fertilizer each year.

Composition:
30% Alkaligrass
30% Boreal Creeping Red Fescue
25% All Star 3 Perennial Ryegrass
15% Park Kentucky Bluegrass

Suggested Seeding Rate: 3½ - 4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.
150 - 175 lbs. per acre
