



DENSE SHADE LAWN MIX

Lawn grasses that are growing in dense shade cannot manufacture enough chlorophyll.

Consequently, the plants grow thin and spindly and are subject to disease. **YOU NEED THE RIGHT GRASS IN THE RIGHT PLACE AT THE RIGHT TIME.**

Our new dense shade mix, with fine fescues, shade tolerant bluegrass and poa trivialis will tolerate densely shaded areas and provide a healthy, dark green lawn.

Poa trivialis is a bright green, fine textured, shallow rooted relative of Kentucky bluegrass. It tolerates heavy shade and also does well in moist soils.

Our dense shade mix will do well in a variety of soils, but will not withstand heavy traffic.

Recommended Usage

Dense Shade Lawn Mix is recommended for residential and commercial lawns and other areas that receive 30 - 75% shade.

Suggested Maintenance

For best results, 1 or 2 applications of fertilizer is recommended annually. If only one application is planned, the fall is the best time to apply it. Shaded turf areas are sensitive to heavy traffic and leaves should be kept cleared in the spring and the fall. Mowing height of 2 - 3 inches is suggested.

Composition:

- 20% Kokomo 2 Perennial Ryegrass
- 15% Boreal Creeping Red Fescue
- 15% Cindy Lou Creeping Red Fescue
- 15% Longfellow II Chewings Fescue
- 15% Silhouette Chewings Fescue
- 10% Skye Kentucky Bluegrass
- 10% Poa Trivialis

Suggested Seeding Rate:

4 - 5 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.
175 - 200 lbs. per acre
