SANDY SOIL BLEND

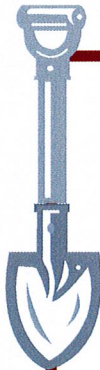
A Lawn Mix Adapted For Sandy, Lite Soils

Composition:

- 20% Longfellow II Chewings Fescue
- 20% Kokomo 2 Perennial Ryegrass
- 20% Boreal Creeping Red Fescue
- 15% Park Kentucky Bluegrass
- 15% Eureka II Hard Fescue
- 10% Cindy Lou Creeping Red Fescue

Features:

- Does especially well in dry, light, sandy soils. Fescues prefer sandy soils.
- Produces a dark green, dense turf requiring low maintenance.
- Will provide fast establishment; some species will germinate in 7 - 10 days.



Suggested Planting Recommendations:

Seed at a rate of 4 pounds per 1,000 square feet.

Seed needs good soil contact for optimum germination.

Water lightly and frequently after seed has been sown.

Turf will respond to a moderate application rate of nitrogen, such as 2 - 3 pounds per 1,000 square feet.
