

# Shady Character



Shady Lawn Seed Mixture is a special formulation of cultivars that offers a combination of shade tolerance and quality turf. Creeping red fescue and chewings fescue excel among lawn grasses with the ability to perform under shady conditions. These fescues also provide quick establishment and tolerate poor soil fertility. Shady Lawn Mix also includes a shade tolerant Kentucky bluegrass with a deep green color, great density and excellent disease resistance. The perennial ryegrass germinates quickly, adapts well to a variety of soils and offers excellent disease resistance. Its dark color, fine texture and mowability make it an ideal choice for mixing with bluegrass and fine fescues.

## Recommended Usage

Shady Lawn Mix is recommended for residential and commercial lawns and other areas that receive 30 - 60% shade.

## Suggested Maintenance

For best results, 1 or 2 applications of fertilizer is recommended annually. If only one application is planned, the fall is the best time to apply it. Shaded turf areas are sensitive to heavy traffic and leaves should be kept cleared in the spring and the fall. Mowing height of 2 - 3 inches is suggested.

### Composition:

- 40% Creeping Red Fescue
- 20% Skye Kentucky Bluegrass
- 20% Fiji Perennial Ryegrass
- 20% Longfellow II Chewings Fescue

### Suggested Seeding Rate:

3½ - 4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.  
150 - 175 lbs. per acre
